TCEQ adopted 02.07.2007


EPA Region 6 approved 04.09.2007

Implementation Strategy for the Revised I-Plan

- Generate stakeholder interest
- Form a Coordination Committee (CC)
- Organize Work Groups (WG)
- WG meet and proposes revisions/additions to the I-Plan
- UCRA staff incorporate revisions/additions
- WG review draft revisions
- UCRA staff incorporates any additional comments into the I-Plan
- Coordination Committee members receive draft prior to meeting
- Meeting held to approve the document by majority vote of CC
- Final Revised I-Plan is submitted to TCEQ
